# Analysis of Election Expenditure Statements of MLAs Himachal Pradesh Assembly Elections, 2017

According to Section 78 of the Representation of the People Act, 1951, every contesting Winner has to lodge a true copy of his election expenses within 30 days from the date of declaration of result of election, with the District Election Officer in all States and Union Territories. Himachal Pradesh Election Watch and Association for Democratic Reforms (ADR) have analyzed all 68 election expenditure statements submitted after the Himachal Pradesh 2017 Assembly for newly elected MLAs. The expenditure limit for the Winners during the Himachal Pradesh Assembly elections was Rs. 28 lakhs. These election expense documents include details of expenses on public meeting and processions, campaigning through electronic and print media, expense on campaign workers, expense on vehicles used and expense on campaign materials.

#### **Recommendations:**

- Each Winner is required to file his election expenditure statement within 30 days of the results of the elections, the deadline in case of the Himachal Pradesh Assembly Elections being the 17<sup>th</sup> January, 2018. It is recommended that the Abstract Expenditure Statement (Annexure 15) of the Winners is uploaded on the website of the CEO within 72 hours of the receipt of the statement.
- 2. The deadline for filing an election petition against any Winner is 45 days after the declaration of the results. Generally, Winners submit their election expenditure statements towards the end of the 30 days given for submission of the statements. This leaves 15 days for any common citizen to file an election petition against any Winner. The deadline for filing an election petition should be increased in order to give the citizens time to scrutinize the election expenditure statements of the Winners and gather the relevant documents/proof etc. for the election petition.
- 3. As has been instated in the filing of affidavits during the elections, the Winners should not be allowed to keep any field blank on the Abstract Election Expenditure statement (Annexure 15) and Schedule 1 to 9. The statements must be filled in a legible format and overwriting of amounts in the statement should be discouraged.

## Summary and Highlights of Election Expenses of MLAs from the Himachal Pradesh Assembly 2017 Elections

- 1. Less than 50% of the Limit: Out of 68 MLAs analysed, 25(37%) MLAs have declared election expenses of less than 50% of the expense limit in their constituency.
- 2. <u>Average Election Expenses</u>: Based on the election expense declarations of 68 MLAs from Himachal Pradesh Assembly, the average amount of money spent by them in the elections is **Rs 15.26 lakhs, which is 55% of the expense limit**.
- Party-wise Average Election Expenses: The party wise average election expenses shows that the average spending for 44 MLAs from BJP is Rs 16.99 lakhs (60.7% of the expense limit). For 21 MLAs from INC, the average election expenditure is Rs 11.80 lakhs (42.2% of the expense limit) and for 2 independent MLAs, the average election expenditure is Rs 16.94 Lakhs (60.5% of the expense limit). 1 MLA from CPI (M) has spent Rs. 8.21 lakhs (29.3% of the expense limit).




Figure 1: Party-wise Average Election Expenses (Rs. in lakhs)








Figure 2: Break Down of Elections Expenses Incurred by MLAs

- 3. <u>Expense on Public Meeting, Rally, and Processions with Star Campaigners</u>: Out of the 68 MLAs analyzed, **12 (18%) MLAs** have declared that **they have not spent any amount on** public meetings, processions etc. with star campaigners.
- 4. <u>Expense on Public Meeting, Rally, and Processions without Star Campaigners</u>: Out of the 68 MLAs analyzed, 6 (9%) MLAs have declared that they have not spent any amount on public meetings, processions etc. without star campaigners.
- 5. <u>Expense on Campaigning through electronic/print media</u>: 16 (23%) MLAs have declared that they have not spent any amount on campaigning through electronic/print media.
- 6. *Expense on Campaign Workers:* 17 (25%) MLAs have declared that they have not spent any amount on campaign workers.
- 7. Expense on Campaign Materials.: 8 (12%) MLAs have declared that they have not spent any amount on campaign materials.
- 8. Expense on Campaign Vehicles.: 3 (4%) MLAs have declared that they have not spent any amount on campaign vehicles.





Figure 3: Party-wise Average Expenses on Public Meetings, Processions etc. with Star Campaigners (Rs. in lakhs)




#### Figure 4: Party-wise Average Expenses on Public Meetings, Processions etc. without Star Campaigners (Rs. in lakhs)







Figure 7: Party-wise Average Expenses on Campaign Vehicles (Rs. in lakhs)

## Summary and Highlights of Funds Raised by MLAs in the Himachal Pradesh Assembly 2017 Elections




Figure 9: Percentage Break-down of Funds Raised by MLAs

- 1. <u>Percentage break-down of funds received by MLAs:</u> Out of the total funds received by MLAs, **57% funds were raised from political** parties, **29% were raised by MLAs themselves** and **14% funds were raised from other sources**.
- 2. <u>MLAs Who Raised Funds from Political Parties</u>: Out of the 68 MLAs analyzed, 20(29%) MLAs have declared that they have not received any funds from political parties.
- 3. <u>MLAs Who Raised Funds through any person/ company/ firm/ associations/ body of persons etc as loan, gift or donation etc:</u> Out of the 68 MLAs analyzed, **31(46%) MLAs** have declared that **they have not received any funds from any person/ company/ firm/** *associations/ body of persons etc as loan, gift or donation etc.*





- 4. <u>Self-funds used for election campaign</u>: Out of the 68 MLAs analyzed, **3 (4%) MLAs** have declared that they have not used any of their own funds for their election campaign.
- 5. <u>Average funds raised from Political Parties (Party-wise)</u>: On an average a MLA from BJP raised 12% and on an average a MLA from INC raised 87% of his/her election expense funds from the political party.
- 6. Average funds raised through any person/company/firm/associations/body of persons etc as loan, gift or donation etc (Party-wise): On an average a MLA from BJP raised 9% of his/her election expense funds from any person/company/firm/associations/body of persons etc. as loan, gift or donation. Similarly, a MLA from INC raised 28% of his/her election expense funds, and 2 independent MLAs raised on an average 48% of their expense funds from any person/ company/ firm/ associations/ body of persons etc. as loan, gift or donation.




Figure 10: Break-down of Election Expenses Incurred by Ministers





- Less than 50% of the Limit: Based on the election expense declarations of all 12 Ministers analysed from Himachal Pradesh Assembly 2017, 3(25%) have declared election expenses of less than 50% of the expense limit in their constituency.
- 2. <u>Average Election Expenditure</u>: Based on the election expense declarations of all 12 Ministers from Himachal Pradesh Assembly 2017, the average amount of money spent by them in the elections is about **Rs 16.87 lakhs, which is 60% of the expense limit**.




Figure 11: Percentage Break-down of Funds Raised by Ministers

- 1. <u>Percentage break-down of funds received by Ministers:</u> Out of the total funds received by Ministers, 74% funds were raised from political parties, 15% were raised by Ministers themselves and 11% funds were raised from other sources.
- 2. <u>Ministers Who Raised Funds from Political Party</u>: Out of the 12 Ministers analyzed, none of the Ministers have declared that they have not received any funds from political parties.
- 3. <u>Ministers Who Raised Funds through any person/ company/ firm/ associations/ body of persons etc as loan, gift or donation</u> <u>etc:</u> Out of the 12 Ministers analyzed, 5
